Requirements for practices

- Supervision is required for all students 6 and under.
- All practises will be done in full costume. All costumes to remain at the theatre.
 <u>Hair</u> to be in a low bun, with a hairnet. (I have a large bag of these so please ask).

 Ballet students to wear ballet tights.
 Please wear flesh coloured underwear, bras and body suits with clear straps.
- Once they have finished all their dances, students may go. (Unless asked to remain for any extra). No need to stay until the end
- A water bottle and some snacks are a good idea, plus maybe some colouring or a book to read. Costumes to be covered when eating and drinking please.
- Practises are closed, (no watching) we don't want to spoil the surprise.
- Practises will start at the above times, so please arrive at the theatre accordingly.

Requirements for Performances

- Students to be at the Theatre <u>45minutes</u> before Curtain Up
- Younger students may sit and watch with parents once done, but only if seating allows. This needs to be done sensibly as we will limit traffic in and out of auditorium
- We are only doing two shows so I would like all students to remain for the final bow at the end.
